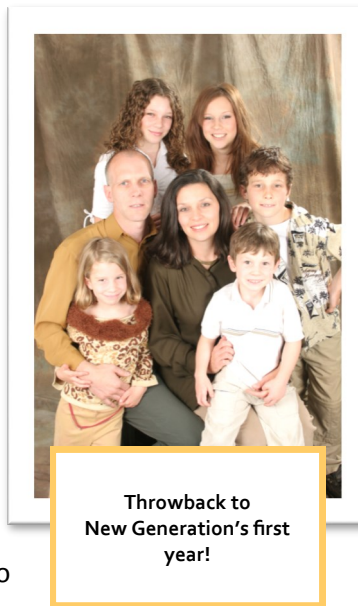
"A New Generation on a Firm Foundation"
