The latest statistics on p-rnography from <http://www.techaddiction.ca/files/porn-addiction-statistics.jpg> are as follows: 12% of internet sites are p-ornographic, 33% of viewers of porn are women, and 70% of men aged 18-24 visit a porn site in a typical month. In the USA \$2.85 BILLION is spent on p-rn in a year, \$4.9 billion worldwide, 25% of all search engine requests are for p-rn, 35% of

internet downloads are p-rn related, and 34% of internet users have experienced unwanted p-rn exposure through pop ups, mis-directed links or emails. The most popular day for viewing porn is Sunday.

I more recently had a vivid vision of Christian men being led through life by their lust rather than by the Spirit of God. Would you join us in prayer and financial support to enable us to speak and work against this scourge on the family in North America and even around the world. Hi Lloyd

Thank you for your email. I sent you a message on your web site last evening with a few details but perhaps it did not get through or perhaps you have not seen it yet. At the risk of being redundant, I will try to reprise that message.

My wife and I met you in Winnipeg, at Calvary Temple in September of 2013. I was struggling with an unforgiving heart. We had just left the church we had attended for 9 years and I was feeling resentful towards some people there who had hurt me. I was also holding resentments toward my wife who had hurt me in her anger because of the ways that I had sinned against her. You prayed for me and encouraged me to forgive.

I also wanted to let you know that God has been teaching me about forgiveness over the past several months. My wife and I attended a home group study on Neil Anderson's Freedom in Christ DVD series. I'm not sure if you also said that refusing to forgive is like drinking poison in the hope that your enemy will die; but that is a line that I remember from that study series. I worked on and am continuing to work through some forgiveness exercises and I find that God is helping me to gradually let go of resentments and forgive.

After attending the Good Friday service at Calvary Temple, I believe I heard Jesus tell me that I have been demanding my "pound of flesh" in return for all the ways I have been hurt by others. Then He told me that He gave, not just a pound, but He gave all His flesh, every ounce, so that I could be forgiven and because of His sacrifice I could forgive those who hurt me too.

Thank you for letting me share. I wish God's richest blessing on you and your family.
