### Mission 66

A year ago, while ministering at Center Hall, PA, the pastor, K. R. Mele, mentioned to Lloyd about a bike trip he was planning to call his country back to Biblical values. He was planning on biking with some other guys who felt the same vision. The plan was to take the 66 books of the bible along Route 66 from Chicago, Illinois to Los Angeles, California, a total trip of about 2500 miles. Something sparked in Lloyd's spirit and he thought, "I would love to do that".

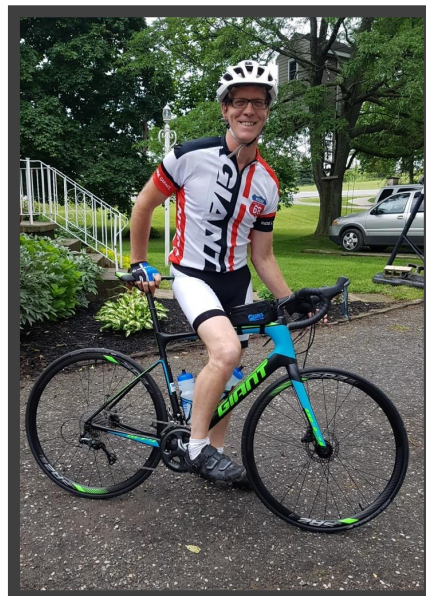
Thinking it was an impossibility, he tucked away the idea in his heart and didn't think too much more about it. This spring, as he started looking the fall itinerary, he began to wonder what God had planned? The area he had tried to book wasn't coming together, and he found he had more open dates than filled ones. Around this time K. R. contacted Lloyd and asked whether he had thought about joining his team on Mission 66. Once again the thought burned in his spirit, "What if I did go on that trip? Could I really pull it off?" He told K.R. he would pray about it and get back to him.

The more he thought and prayed about it the more he felt like God was saying, "Go." "Go, and get a fresh vision for what I want to do in America. Go, and get a new compassion for the lost. Go, and inspire these men you are riding with as they inspire you to reach a nation that has fallen so far from its Christian heritage. Go and I will bless it."

On May 23<sup>rd</sup> Lloyd read 1 Samuel 10:7, "Once these signs are fulfilled, do whatever your hand finds to do, for God is with you." He felt that this verse applied to what he was considering. So, that is what he is going to do.

On September 6 he and the team are going to begin riding 80 - 100 miles a day for 6 days a week until they arrive in California 4 1/2 weeks later. They plan to preach at specific churches each Sunday and share the Gospel to every one they meet along the way.

The cost \$1500 (usd) for food and accommodation. \$450 Flights from Toronto to Chicago and from LA to Toronto. There will also be no income from ministry for 5 Sundays.
