I bicycled 2400 miles from Chicago, IL to Santa Monica, CA in 32 days from September 6th to October 8th. Our purpose in going was to take the 66 books of the Bible through the heart of America, Route 66.

Here are some highlights from one day on this trip:

I met Ted at the McDonald's, he was so broken. As I began to tell him about the Lord his eyes teared and he shared his story with me. Two failed marriages, a son who died a couple years ago, and many other really sad things. He wants to live for the Lord now. He said he was a Christian but he needed to do a lot better job at it.

He was locked in the chicken coop by his brother and sister when he was 8 years old. He was emotionally and physically abused and thus filled with anger for many, many years. He said he still has a bad temper so I prayed for him. You can pray for him too as he comes to your memory

At the end of the day I took one guy to the shower at the Flying J. While waiting, a guy named Trevor begin to talk to me out of the blue. His girlfriend had just broken up with him two days before and he was hurting really bad. In the period of about 10 minutes he

smoked four cigarettes. He was so discouraged he was thinking of taking his own life. He'd been raped when he

was 8 years old. I spoke with him at length and eventually the guy that was with me and I prayed with him.

As I was getting ready to leave I thought to give him a hug. He wrapped his arms around my shoulders and cried and cried probably for 2 minutes. Very, very draining but incredibly rewarding. People need the love of Jesus to flow through us to them.
