TESTIMONY from a young man in one of our services....

Hey man! I just wanted to tell you how much your ministry means to me, and also how necessary I believe it is today. Your story is similar to mine. I was physically abused by my mother growing up, sent to work with my dad when I was twelve. My first exposure to porn was at age eleven, when I accidentally found some magazines hidden by someone else. Porn was always my escape from my mom and all her strictness and beatings. (on a typical day at home, I'd get beat more than 100 times).

Amazingly, I've always known that God had called and anointed me for ministry - it's all I've ever wanted to do. I was always bound by porn though. I could NEVER go more than one month without it. Hard as I tried, one month would be the max, and I couldn't go any longer. I know the constant struggle, guilt, shame of doing "ministry", while struggling with this sin... and not able to break free.

I was in a really dark place in life this last winter, sick of being bound to this sin with no hope of ever breaking away from it. Over the winter, I was without work for about 2 months, and searching... really searching for answers, wanting change, significant change. Someone from church gave me a book from a Christian life coach, and I really didn't take it seriously, but out of boredom from not working I started reading every morning. The message in the book started to change my life! What happened is that I started to develop a daily routine; reading and praying first thing every morning.

Two days before my birthday I renounced this sin and repented, and have not looked back. It's been about two and a half months now (I could never make it past a month before) and I have seriously never known this freedom before. My attitude and demeanor changed and I have joy and purpose for the first time in my life. Most importantly though, I have a relationship with the Father. I have known about God all my life, but now I KNOW God. The Holy Spirit spoke to me yesterday, that what the enemy had stolen from me was fellowship with the Father; and as a result of that, favor with the Father - which is now restored!

So man, **your testimony**, it really hit home to me Sunday. I've never known someone to share something like that as a ministry before. I can't help but wonder how many others are out there just like (me).
