Dealing with the lie prepared me for things that were coming. There is a continuation of the growth that began there.

It's given me a confidence to walk forward with the Lord. I was able to take scripture and per-

sonalize it for me.
I now choose to

obey the Holy Spirit and not my sinful nature. I don't think I would be where I am today had I not asked Cathy for the prayer time. God has blessed my relationships as well."

Her final words, "Counseling is more like head knowledge. Transformation Prayer gets the truth into your soul and spirit."

While traveling from Claresholm, Alberta to Wisconsin Dells, WI the bus batteries caught on fire. We were at a rest area just outside Menomonie WI taking a break when we "happened" to step outside to get some fresh air for a minute. Lloyd looked to the back of the bus when he noticed smoke billowing from the engine compartment. Running to get the fire



extinguisher (he'd never used in 11 years) trying desperately to remember where it was. Once Lloyd found it he had the fire out in moments. He was literally shaking with shock once the fire was out. Seven hours later, with four new batteries, cables, battery equalizer and a few (melted) airline repairs we were back on the road. Thank God we didn't have the fire while we were driving.
